#### 2. Meeting people - 5 Points to remember

'First impressions' are very important, and the way you behave when you introduce yourself can have a lasting effect. This is true in formal & informal situations.

Here are some points to help you make a good impression:

- 1 Shake hands use a firm grip. A hand shake should last for about 2 seconds.
- 2 Speak slowly and clearly, don't babble.
- 3 Smile and keep eye contact, don't fidget.
- 4 Start your introduction with a greeting
- 5 Listen carefully to the other person remember their name


